I am writing to you to complement you on the security of your windows. We had the house double glazed with white UPVC in 2000/01. I'm not sure of the actual date without rooting out the receipt.

About 3 weeks ago we found that the window at the back of the house was subject to an attempted break-in. The window was on "Vent Lock" at the time so there was a small gap which enabled the, would be burglars, to get a crowbar or a very large screw driver into the gap. They must have tried 4 or 5 times to open the window judging from the number of dents they made in the window, to no avail. I really didn't think about this until the Police came and commented "Well there is one consolation, you now know how safe you are because they really tried to get in and didn't manage it".

I have recommended Faron Crown to all my friends; because the product is excellent and well fitted also I understand that it is even more secure now, with the changes since I had my windows done.

Just as a little postscript, I also like the fact that they never "Pressure Sell" like a lot of the other larger Double Glazing Companies.
